## **Recommended action**

We maintain our recommendations: LT fundamental Buy and ST relative Overweight, for the equities of Voxel. We expect good 4Q21 financials stemming predominantly from testing for SARS-CoV-2 virus, higher yoy against the high base (we assume 147,000 tests for SARS-CoV-2 to have been performed in 4Q21 vs 142,000 in 4Q20). We expect to see a significant increase in a volume of diagnostic services (we assume 70,000 procedures at Voxel which implies a 30% yoy growth). FY21 financial results will be released on April 11.

# **4Q21** financial results preview

In 1Q/ 2Q/ 3Q21 the volume of scans performed reached 55,000 (up 12% yoy)/ 37,000 (down 37% yoy)/ 53,000 (down 11% yoy)/ 54,000 (down 8% yoy) and 58,000 (up 5% yoy)/ 63,000 (up 71% yoy)/ 71,000 (up 33% yoy) in 1Q/ 2Q/ 3Q21. In 4Q21 we assume Voxel performed 70,000 procedures altogether (up 30% yoy), including 26,000 (up 36% yoy)/ 40,000 (up 26% yoy)/ 4,000 (up 31% yoy) CT/ MRI/ PET scans. We estimate Voxel's 4Q21 non-consolidated revenues at PLN 46 million (up 26% yoy).

We forecast 4Q21 revenues of RP/ Scanix/ Exira/ Vito-Med/ Alteris at PLN 2/6/2/46/79 million (Alteris supplies Vito-Med with necessary materials and equipment; we estimate that c. PLN 42 million of these PLN 79 million may be subject to consolidation exclusions).

We forecast the Group's consolidated revenues to reach PLN 138 million and expect the profitability improvement resulting from a higher volume of SARS-CoV-2 tests and diagnostic services performed. As regards Vito-Med, we expect a loss on the inpatient services (hospital). We forecast the Group's EBIT and NP to reach PLN 29 million and PLN 21 million, respectively, in 4Q21.

#### Guide to adjusted profits

Results adjusted for gains on the occasional purchase of Scanix, real estate disposal, and write-offs.

## 2022E outlook

The price of a single SARS-CoV-2 test under the NFZ contract has dropped since January 1 from PLN 280 to PLN 113 which will affect the Group's financials, in particular the profitability that will drop considerably.

Nevertheless, given the fact that in January a number of SARS-CoV-2 tests performed exceeded 3 million in Poland (twice as much as in October or November) and is on the rise (Omicron), we assume that in January a number of tests for SARS-CoV-2 that Voxel performed may have reached c. 100,000 and February may witness a similar volume. In March we assume a lower volume of tests performed in the Group and forecast 1Q22 revenues/ income from this source to drop to PLN 30/ 10 million (down yoy). We expect a volume of diagnostic services (CT, MRI, PET, SPECT) to increase yoy in 1Q22 and, therefore, 1Q22 financials may be flat yoy and high in nominal values.

We assumed a significant yoy decline of the revenues from SARS-CoV-2 tests in FY22 and expect the Group's results deterioration this year. We modified our forecasts just slightly and uphold our assumptions. Voxel has already started preparations to include genetic tests in their services, which should mitigate somehow the expected decline in a number of tests for SARS-CoV-2. As regards Vito-Med, we expect a profitability growth on the inpatient services (hospital). A strong growth should prevail, we believe, in the diagnostic segment, albeit the Group will have to deal with the pressure on wages.

## **Valuation**

In spite of the forecast modifications, our 12M EFV being a mix of the DCF valuation and peer-relative valuation (50%-50%) drops to PLN 60.2 per share (by 5%) due to the risk-free rate and market premium update (to 4% and 5.5%, respectively) and change of the peer companies multiples. The DCF FCF/ peer-relative valuation implies PLN 60.3/ PLN 60.0 per share.

sensitivity to undertaken assumptions, especially those

related to the residual value calculation. Assumptions used in valuation can change, influencing thereby the level of the valuation. Among the most important assumptions are: GDP growth, forecasted level of inflation, changes in interest rates and currency prices, employment level and change in wages, demand on the analysed company products, raw material prices, competition, standing of the main customers and suppliers, legislation changes, etc. Changes in the environment of the analysed company are monitored by analysts involved in the preparation of the recommendation, estimated, incorporated in valuation and published in the recommendation whenever needed.

#### **KEY TO INVESTMENT RANKINGS**

This is a guide to expected price performance in absolute terms over the next 12 months:

Buy – fundamentally undervalued (upside to 12M EFV in excess of the cost of equity) + catalysts which should close the valuation gap identified;

Hold - either (i) fairly priced, or (ii) fundamentally undervalued/overvalued but lacks catalysts which could close the valuation gap;

Sell - fundamentally overvalued (12M EFV < current share price + 1-year cost of equity) + catalysts which should close the valuation gap identified.

This is a guide to expected relative price performance:

Overweight – expected to perform better than the benchmark (WIG) over the next quarter in relative terms

Neutral – expected to perform in line with the benchmark (WIG) over the next quarter in relative terms

Underweight – expected to perform worse than the benchmark (WIG) over the next quarter in relative terms

The recommendation tracker presents the performance of DM BOŚ S.A.'s recommendations. A recommendation expires on the day it is altered or on the day 12 months after its issuance, whichever comes first.

Relative performance compares the rate of return on a given recommended stock in the period of the recommendation's validity (i.e. from the date of issuance to the date of alteration or – in case of maintained recommendations – from the date of issuance to the current date) in a relation to the rate of return on the benchmark in this time period. The WIG index constitutes the benchmark. For recommendations that expire by an alteration or are maintained, the ending values used to calculate their absolute and relative performance are: the stock closing price on the day the recommendation expires/ is maintained and the closing value of the benchmark on that date.
