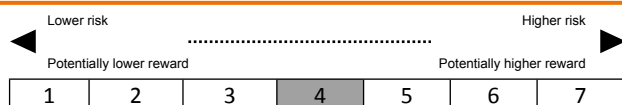

Objectives and investment policy

The fund is passively managed. The aim is for your investment to reflect the performance of the Markit iBoxx EUR Liquid High Yield Index (index). The index reflects the performance of the largest and the most liquid sub-investment grade corporate bonds denominated in Euro and issued by companies based both inside and outside of the Eurozone. For new bonds to be included in the index, they must, on the relevant rebalancing date, have a minimum remaining time to maturity of at least two years and a maximum of up to ten and a half years. The bonds can have a fixed or floating rate of interest and must be rated less than Baa3/BBB- by major rating agencies. The weight of an issuer in the index is capped at 3% and the weight of a country in the index is capped at 20% of the market value of the index at the rebalancing date. The size of individual bonds from an issuer is capped in relation to their market value.

The index is administered by IHS Markit Benchmark Administration Limited and reviewed and rebalanced monthly. To achieve the aim, the fund will attempt to replicate the index by buying a portfolio of securities that may comprise the constituents of the index or other unrelated investments as determined by DWS entities. The fund may employ techniques and instruments in order to manage risk, reduce costs and improve results. These techniques and instruments may include the use of financial contract(s) (derivative(s)). The fund may also engage in secured lending of its investments to certain eligible third parties to generate additional income to offset the costs of the fund. The currency of the fund is EUR. The fund distributes up to four times per annum. You may request the redemption of shares generally on a daily basis.

Risk and reward profile



The calculation of the risk and reward profile is based on historical data that cannot be used as a reliable indicator for the future risk profile. This risk indicator is subject to changes; the classification of the fund may change over time and cannot be guaranteed. Even a fund that is classified in the lowest category (category 1) does not represent a completely risk-free investment. The fund is classified in category 4 because its share price fluctuates and the likelihood of both losses and gains may therefore be relatively high. The following risks could be of particular significance for the fund: The fund will attempt to replicate the performance of the index less costs, but your investment is not expected to match the performance of the index precisely. Exceptional circumstances may arise, such as, but not limited to, disruptive market conditions, additional costs/taxes or extremely volatile markets, which may cause the fund's performance to be substantially different from the performance of the index. DWS entities and related companies may act in several roles in relation to the fund such as distributor and management company which may involve conflicts of interest.

The fund is not guaranteed and your investment is at risk. The value of your investment may go down as well as up. The index is rules-based and is not capable of being adjusted to take into account changing market circumstances. An investor may be negatively affected by, or may not benefit from, the lack of such adjustments. The fund may use derivatives in an attempt to efficiently manage the portfolio. It may be that the use of derivatives will not have the desired result and can cause share prices to fluctuate which may in turn result in the fund and your investment suffering a loss. Investors should be aware that, due to there being no sector allocation cap, the index may become more concentrated to a particular sector and/or sectors. The fund invests in non-investment grade bonds which generally have a higher risk of default and are more susceptible to market fluctuations than investment grade bonds. This may affect the value of your investment. The fund may invest in bonds which are exposed to credit risk and interest rate risk. Credit risk means that there is a risk that the bond issuer may be unable to pay interest or repay the bond principal, resulting in your investment suffering a loss. Interest rate risk means that if interest rates rise, typically the value of the bond will fall, which could also affect the value of your investment.

Charges

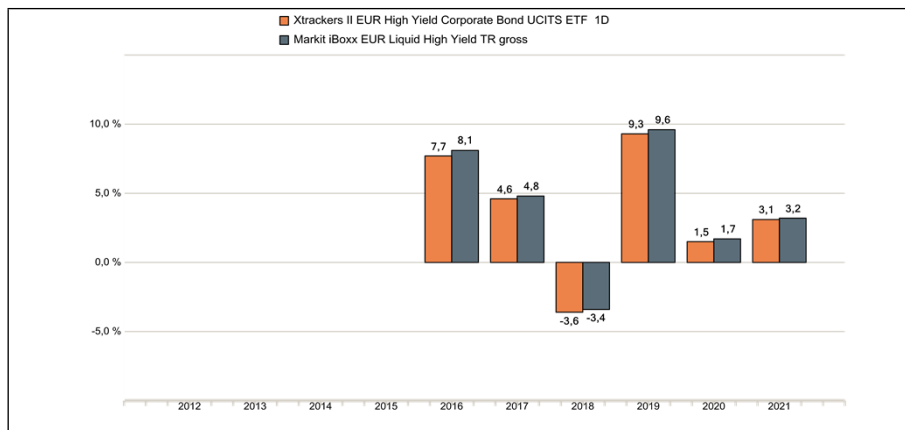
Secondary market investors (those who buy or sell shares on a stock exchange) may be charged certain fees by their stock broker. These charges, if any, can be obtained from such stock broker. Authorised participants dealing directly with the fund will pay the transaction costs related to their subscriptions and redemptions.

The ongoing charges figure is based on expenses for the fiscal year ending 31.12.2021. It may vary from year to year. It excludes portfolio transaction costs and performance fees, if any.

To the extent the fund undertakes securities lending to generate revenue, the fund will ultimately be allocated 70% of the associated gross revenue. The remaining 30% will be allocated to the management company, out of which it (i) retains 5% of such 30% (that is 1.5% of the overall gross revenues generated from such transactions) for its own coordination and oversight tasks, (ii) pays the direct costs to external service providers, and (iii) pays such revenues as remain following payment of (i) and (ii) to the Investment Manager for supporting the management company in initiating, preparing and implementing securities lending transactions, as set out in the prospectus. As securities lending revenue sharing does not increase the costs of running the fund, this has been excluded from the ongoing charges.
